

Large stature succulents from around the world; a glimpse into the diversity of growth forms.




South America

Cacti and bromeliads from arid regions in Argentina, Chile, Peru, Bolivia and Brazil.




North America


Epiphytes

A cross-section of the diversity of tropical and subtropical succulent epiphytes.




Woody Succulents

Cold Frames

Low-growing cacti and members of the midday flower and orpine families that need a lot of light and fresh air to flourish.



Rockery

Open-air garden with winter-hardy succulents (mainly cacti and members of the orpine family) from around the world.
